- **Fast riders out– Beginning at 9am**
- **Slow/Moderate riders out after 9:30am**
- **Last riders out by 12:00pm**
- **No second ride entries accepted**

Entry fee:

- **\$40 Adult rider**
- **\$20 Juniors (17 & under)**

- **Water will be available on the grounds for horses & riders**

- **Event is open to ALL riders: English, Western, Side, Gaited or other.**
**Saddles required*
- **No measuring devices of any kind are allowed.**

What is a Hunter Pace?

A hunter pace is a competitive trail ride designed to closely match the excitement of a fox hunt.

Guidelines: Teams of 1 to 3 riders follow a marked cross-country course, with the goal of completing the course in as close to the ideal time as possible. Riders may choose to jump the obstacles or go around them. Course distance is between 3 and 6 miles.

Divisions:

Slow: Desired pace of 4 mph
Medium: Desired pace of 7 mph
**Slow/moderate riders may ride out after 9:30am*
Fast: Desired pace of 10 mph
**Fast riders must ride out by 9:30am*

**** Helmets required for all mounted riders– On or Off the course ****

Awards available for pickup beginning Weds July 12 at Park office by appointment, or at any of the remaining 2023 Rocky Fork paces.
