


Right around sunset is the best time to see bats. If you want to witness them flying above your head, find a nice hiking trail with open areas near water. You might not see bats on the first try so don't get discouraged and keep trying! Bats can see with their eyes, but can also "see" using echolocation. They make a sound that bounces off an object in front of them and it comes back as an echo the bat can hear. This echo helps them find prey and other objects in the night. Can you do the same? Check the QR code for games to play alone or with friends! These games will help you understand how echolocation works even though human ears are not as good at hearing as bats are.
