

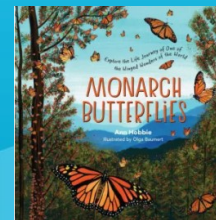

## INVESTIGATION CARD

Look at the anatomy of a butterfly on pages 14-15. Draw your own diagrams in your journal. Find a butterfly outside and follow it around for a while. Watch how it lands on flowers and uses its antennae and proboscis. Notice what types and colors of flowers it lands on and how much time it spends on each flower. Record your observations in your **journal**. Watch out for butterflies landing on puddles or muddy patches. You could even try to find some milkweed plants. Look on the backs of the leaves for eggs. Can you see any caterpillars or 'frass' on the stems? Make your own 'puddler' to attract butterflies using the QR code!
